



# Williamson Youth Track

The Williamson Youth Track Club was formed five years ago to encourage youth (ages 8-17) to get involved in the sports of track and field and cross country. The club started with 11 athletes and had one national qualifier in its first year to now having within a six year period over 150 athletes registered per year in track and field and cross country, a total of 12 national medalist, 14 Nationally ranked All-Americans, and over 50 National ranked honor roll athletes. Williamson Youth Track Club is a non-profit organization, and an affiliate of the Amateur Athletic Union (AAU) and a member of USA Track and Field (USATF) organizations. The club competes in both AAU and USATF meets. The club hosts a few meets each year, but has to travel out of the area for most of its meets in places like Knoxville, Birmingham, AL, Orlando, FL, Charlotte, NC, Detroit, MI, Omaha, NE, Des Moines IA, Hampton, VA, and New Orleans, LA.

## Club highlights for year 2010:

- ❖ Won the Tennessee and Third Annual Williamson Youth Invitational Track Meets
- ❖ Won the USATF Tennessee Association Track Meet.
- ❖ Hosted the Third Williamson Youth Invitational Track Meet.
- ❖ Had 44 National Junior Olympic Qualifiers in 88 events

- ❖ Youth boys (ages 13 & 14) captured AAU District Championships in Track and Field.
- ❖ One athlete claimed the Tennessee Middle School State Cross Country Championship and four girls and three boys earned all state honors.
- ❖ Had 17 runners medal and 3 of them earned All-American honors at the Cross-Country Coaches National Youth Championships.
- ❖ Youth girls Cross-Country team won the AAU District Championship.
- ❖ Youth girls (ages 13-14) finished 4<sup>th</sup> at the Cross Country Coaches National Youth Championships.
- ❖ Youth boys (ages 13-14) finished 5<sup>th</sup> at the Cross Country Coaches National Youth Championships.
- ❖ Club Membership went to over 100 athletes registered total for both Track and Field and Cross Country.

- ❖ One athlete place 3rd in 3000 at indoor nationals.
- ❖ 8 State Champions and 23 medal winners in USATF Association Championship Meet.
- ❖ 11 individuals plus 2 relay teams qualified for AAU Youth Track Nationals in Knoxville.
- ❖ 13-14 boys team qualified for Nationals in cross country with one boy placing 8th and earning All-American honors by finishing in the top 10.
- ❖ State Middle School Cross Country Champion.
- ❖ AAU Southeast District Cross Country Champion and USATF Cross Country Champion.
- ❖ Club membership went from 35 the first season to 57 in 2008.

## **Club highlights for year 2008:**

- ❖ Boys ages 9&10 and 11&12 won the Tennessee Youth Invitational Track Meet.
- ❖ Hosted our first invitational track meet where our 9&10 and 11&12 boys claimed team titles.
- ❖ 16 athletes qualified for Junior Olympic Nationals, including one silver medalist who narrowly missed setting a national record in the high jump.
- ❖ 3 girls earned All-State Middle School Cross Country honors, including one who captured the Middle School Cross Country Regional Championship.
- ❖ Our youth girl's team claimed the AAU Southeast District Cross Country crown and finished 7th in the National Junior Olympics Meet.
- ❖ Club Membership went from 57 the previous season to over 100 athletes this past year.
